OFF-SEASON GROUP RATES 2010 – 2011

WATERFRONT – All groups using the waterfront area are required to have a minimum of two lifeguards with one who is at least 21 years of age with current certification with the American Red Cross, and written documentation that he or she has demonstrated skills in rescue and emergency procedures specific to the aquatic area and activities guarded. Certification must be current. Alpine Camp for Boys, Inc will assist the group in hiring qualified lifeguards to serve the group. The group will pay these individuals directly at the end of the day. If the group uses watercraft, Alpine Camp for Boys will provide a person with instructor rating in the appropriate craft from a nationally recognized certifying body, and the group will be responsible for paying this individual for their services at the end of the day. Canoe rentals are \$15.00 per canoe per day.

If the **ROPES COURSE** is to be used by your group, prior arrangements must be made with Alpine Camp. We recommend as much advance notice as possible in order that qualified instructors may be enlisted to work with your group on the course. Only appropriately trained staff, approved by Alpine Camp, may supervise the use of the course by the licensee. Alpine Camp will endeavor to enlist the necessary staff to operate the ropes course for you. We require a minimum of three instructors. The licensee pays these individuals separately, and Alpine's Off-Season Director can furnish you with a range of fees charged by these instructors. Alpine recommends a 10:1 ratio of participants to instructor. In addition to the fee for the instructors, there is a fee of \$5.00 a day per participant for use of the ropes course.

SWIMMING POOL: Use of the Alpine swimming pool requires the following daily charge:

Group Size	Daily Charge
35-100	\$250
100-250	\$350

In addition to the daily charge for use of the pool, groups will also be responsible for lifeguard charges and a pool-heating surcharge if they choose to have the pool heated. The pool-heating surcharge will be equal to the cost of the propane used to heat the pool (usually about \$350 per 24hrs of heating).

Groups will have the use of all athletic facilities, but will be responsible for furnishing their own balls and equipment. If the group does use any of Alpine Camp for Boys' equipment, there will be a \$100.00 equipment fee charge for the group.

Alpine Camp for Boys, Inc. considers these rates binding for the date your group books. A final count of participants must be given to the Alpine Camp Office five days prior to the group's arrival. The group will be charged for meals for the number given to us on that date unless the group adds to this number and in this case the group will be charged for the actual number of participants served.
